ESLA insurance program review is ongoing (John, Phil, Jim Parker-ret. Ins. agent)

Looking at legal /insurance needs and will make a recommendation to the board

Antrim County, lake level issues

George contacted Leslie Myers – drain commissioner and dam/water level facilitator

Received letter in March from Clam lake residents on high water /flooding cause by rain and snow melt

Problem with 1 turbine (the ER dam had 4 gates for pass through originally, but there are only 2 existing slots/turbine (2 are closed off) and 1 turbine was not working. This has been repaired.

She is talking to Antrim county commissioners for money to make improvements— there is a lake Level committee (Tom Pierce/George are part of this- meeting next week) - added \$125,000 for improvement in spillways (in 1974 lake levels were established, the county established a special assessments district).

Counties involved: Kalkaska, Antrim, Grand Traverse- may include some of Charlevoix county.

Bellaire dam is working on improvements- county asked for some funds – letter of support provide by George- but this was denied since engineering plans weren't far enough along.

Milton township sent a letter out about dock length and shoreline buffers – reviewing shoreline buffers to be more specific on trees and site on shoreline

Elk rapids overflow facility is working on improvements

Tip of the Mitt is having a meeting June 12- in Petoskey to hear what other lake organizations are doing.

Zone meetings have been scheduled.

Bouys have been placed in the Torch river – Pat Pierce is still looking for a couple missing ones
